- Books
- Movies & TV Shows
- Photographs
- Illustrations and Vectors
- Research
- Maps
- Articles



New Public Domain Developments



- In 2019, protected work was released into the public domain for the first time in over 20 years. And now there will be a flood gate of new content each year.
- There's a tremendous amount of media available to work with. For a small sample, that means you can use Charlie Chaplin movies, Frost's poetry, or Felix the Cat cartoons.



Public Domain Monetization Examples
